There are 19 national scholarship opportunities within APhA-ASP all of which appeal to a variety of skill sets and experiences!



AWARDS

There are five national APhA-ASP awards conferred annually in addition to an APhA-ASP Senior Recognition Certificate (awarded to a final year student pharmacist in each APhA-ASP chapter).

CONFERENCES

Midyear Regional Meeting (MRM):
Occurring in your region of the country each fall, you do not want to miss this opportunity to get to know APhA-ASP chapter members from your area, learn about pharmacy policy, and other opportunities in APhA-ASP.

Annual Meeting:
Each March, APhA-ASP members gather from across the country to network and discuss issues impacting pharmacy today.

Summer Leadership Institute:
The Summer Leadership Institute brings APhA-ASP Chapter Leaders from across the country to Washington D.C. for a weekend each July. These students have the opportunity to meet with legislators in the US Capitol in addition to networking with other student pharmacists from across the country, sharing ideas and helping one another prepare for the year ahead as APhA-ASP leaders.



The APhA Institute on Substance Use Disorders :

The Institute allows student pharmacists to gain patient perspectives on substance use disorders directly from those impacted. Students learn the pharmacology and pathophysiology of the disorders, as well as patient care strategies and develop an understanding on how to assist other students and patients as providers in their own communities.
